

### Project Overview

**Purpose** - Improve intersection at Route 609 and Route 602 to address safety concerns

**Total Estimated Cost** - \$2.28 million

Engineering of roadway plans: \$493K

Right of way acquisition & utility relocation: \$456K

Construction: \$1.33 million

**Project Length** – 0.88 miles

Begin construction – Spring 2017


End construction and closeout project– Fall 2017





The project will reconfigure the intersection of Route 609 and Route 602 to improve flow of traffic through the intersection and improve the safety. The “triangle” will be removed and the “right of way” for motorists will be clarified.




Existing intersection

## Proposed Detour




★ Fire/rescue Station at 7100 Adkins Road

- The proposed detour is 11.7 miles (about 17 minutes).
- Barnetts Road will be closed, just south of the intersection with Lott Cary Road for about 0.1 mile.
- Lott Cary Road will remain open during detour. Barnetts Road, to the north of intersection, will also remain open during detour.
- The detour will occur over one weekend. It will begin on a Friday at 6:00 pm and end before 6:00 am on Monday morning.
- The detour should have minimal or no impact on school buses, landfill operations, or fire/rescue responses.



*Access to property will be maintained for property owners in the area.*
