WHAT IS TRIAD?

Triad is a partnership consisting of the local sheriff and/or police chief, seniors, and senior service providers in a community who agree to work together to reduce criminal victimization of the elderly. Important to a Triad is an advisory council of law enforcement leaders and older persons, which serves as a sounding board, information channel and catalyst for renewing emphasis on reducing crimes against the elderly and assisting with identifying resources for our aging population.

WHY IS TRIAD NECESSARY?

Older Americans make up the fastest-growing segment of the population. By 2025, 25% of Virginia's population will be age 60 and up. This statistic will continue to rise. Criminals prey on older Americans and Triad works to prevent exploitation and victimization in this segment of the population.
